State-of-the-art technology services are available to help seniors and adults with disabilities receive the added security and comfort of help at their fingertips 24 hours a day, to complement the in-home care they may already be receiving.

Our personal emergency response system (PERS) connects to your existing phone line and has a two-way built-in speaker, allowing you to call a remote call center in case of an emergency. If you are unable to speak when connected, emergency services will be sent immediately.

The Medication Management System (MMS) reminds clients when it is time to take their medication and dispenses pills and/or tablets at the touch of a button.

Our TeleCheck Monitoring Program offers families a cost-effective way to check in on the safety and welfare of a loved one, up to 3 times per day with a customized phone call check-in to see how a loved one is feeling, give medication reminders, and provide meal checks.

Care when and where you need it most

In-home services for clients age 18 and older are available wherever you call home: in your own home, apartment, assisted living or nursing home. All in-home services are private-pay. Some insurance and public funding programs may also be available to cover the cost of care.
