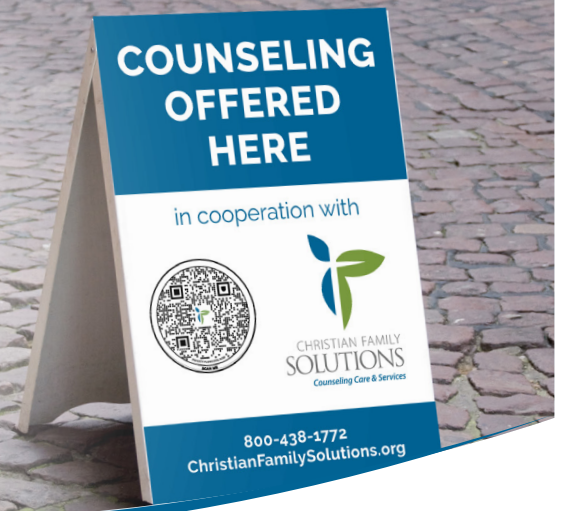


# Community Counseling Care Partnerships

We're seeing higher levels of need for counseling care within congregations and in their communities. People are seeking help with issues such as anxiety, depression, addictions, marital and relationship troubles, trauma, and more. How do we meet these needs with Christian love and care?

The CFS **Community Counseling Care Partnership** seeks to improve mental health and well-being in the congregation and its community over time. Together, we can support those who need education, pastoral care, and/or clinical care that is properly integrated with God's Word.

Our program options allow the congregation to access a level of care and professional expertise it might not be able to attain on its own.

- The congregation can provide ministry-oriented programs such as support groups, spiritual counseling, and Bible classes.
- CFS provides professional counseling services on site on a medical model, meaning clients typically use insurance or self-pay for clinical services.

Since we know that mental health and spiritual health are intertwined, this partnership is both a medical and a spiritual service to the community. Together we can reflect the ministry of Jesus Christ, who healed and helped people in need, both physically and spiritually.



CFS is a professional Christian counseling organization with 110+ licensed professionals and mental health practitioners whose calling is to heal and help people in need.

A partnership between CFS and a congregation leverages all available resources from the congregation, CFS, medical insurance, and grants/donations to effectively address mental health and wellness issues.

### In general, the agreement calls for the congregation to provide:



- Private rooms for counselor(s) to meet with clients in a clinical setting
- A separate entrance and waiting room for clinical services
- Internet service
- Referrals for clinical services at the level specified in the agreement
- Financial support to cover administrative costs of offering clinical services on site, per the agreement

### CFS provides:



- A licensed mental health professional to work on site
- Training for the clinician and access to essential systems for documentation and licensure
- Liability and malpractice insurance
- Support teams to handle calls, intake, and billing for outpatient services
- Supervision of the clinical work and site required by your state regulations
- Secure telehealth capabilities when client or clinician is not on site
- Education for congregation to help them understand how to access services
- Access to a team with broad experience, expertise, and levels of care
- Signage for clinical services
- Potential gain share: When overhead costs are covered and clinic revenue exceeds direct expenses, the congregation and CFS share in any gains
